



Bodegas Torroja is located in the village of El Azagador, in the Valencian district of Utiel - Requena. It is a family-run business, the product of a deep-rooted winemaking tradition that has been passed down through generations.

The old family winery founded in 1910 has been thoroughly restored and modernized though certain traditional features have been preserved such as the old underground wine vats that have been converted into cellars where our wines can rest as they age.

The winery has built a solid reputation for producing young, fresh wines with focused primary fruit flavors and mature “Crianza” wines with structure, elegance and finesse that are aged in American and French Oak barrels.

The grape varieties used in our wines are Tempranillo, Bobal, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Chardonnay and especially Tardana. Sadly this local variety is suffering from massive regression in the area. Bodegas Torroja has devoted substantial effort since 1999 to reviving this somewhat peculiar indigenous white variety and remains the only winery in the world to bottle it.
