Grape Varieties: 75% Garnacha and
25% Tempranillo

Barrel Aging: Aged for a minimum of six months in American oak barrels to add complexity.

Flavor Profile: A wine with deep color and complex, full, elegant flavors with a soft, pleasing finish.

Serving Suggestions: Serve at room temperature with all foods. Best when opened one hour before serving.

Bodegas Aragonesas is the largest wine estate in Spain's Campo de Borja region, where grapes have been grown for over 800 years. Our estate is favored with an unusually dry climate that guarantees a consistently excellent harvest. The vineyards are rocky, highly elevated and ideally exposed to the sun, resulting in perfect ripeness and flavor. While we continue to plant new grape varieties like Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah to enhance our wines' complexity, we use primarily old vine Grenache. These Grenache vineyards - some planted over 100 years ago - produce exceptionally low yields ensuring deep ruby color and rich, full-bodied flavors that are both soft and complex. We invite you to try our wines and experience their quality for yourself.
