Carl Ehrhard and his family tend 22 acres of Riesling and Pinot Noir spread throughout four prime vineyards around the town of Rudesheim in the Rheingau region of Germany. The estate was founded in 1815 and taken over in 1998 by Carl, his wife Petra and their three daughters. The Ehrhards strive to make wines endowed with personality that express the unique character of their vineyards. The four vineyards – Berg Rottland, Berg Roseneck, Bischofsberg, and Kirchenpfad are situated on the steep banks of the Rhein River and are maintained without the use of fertilizers or herbicides. In the winery, the Ehrhard’s embrace traditional methods and preserve fruit purity through minimal intervention, but with use of modern equipment. These precise, powerful wines are lively and fresh in their youth and develop great depth and character while maintaining clarity as they age.
